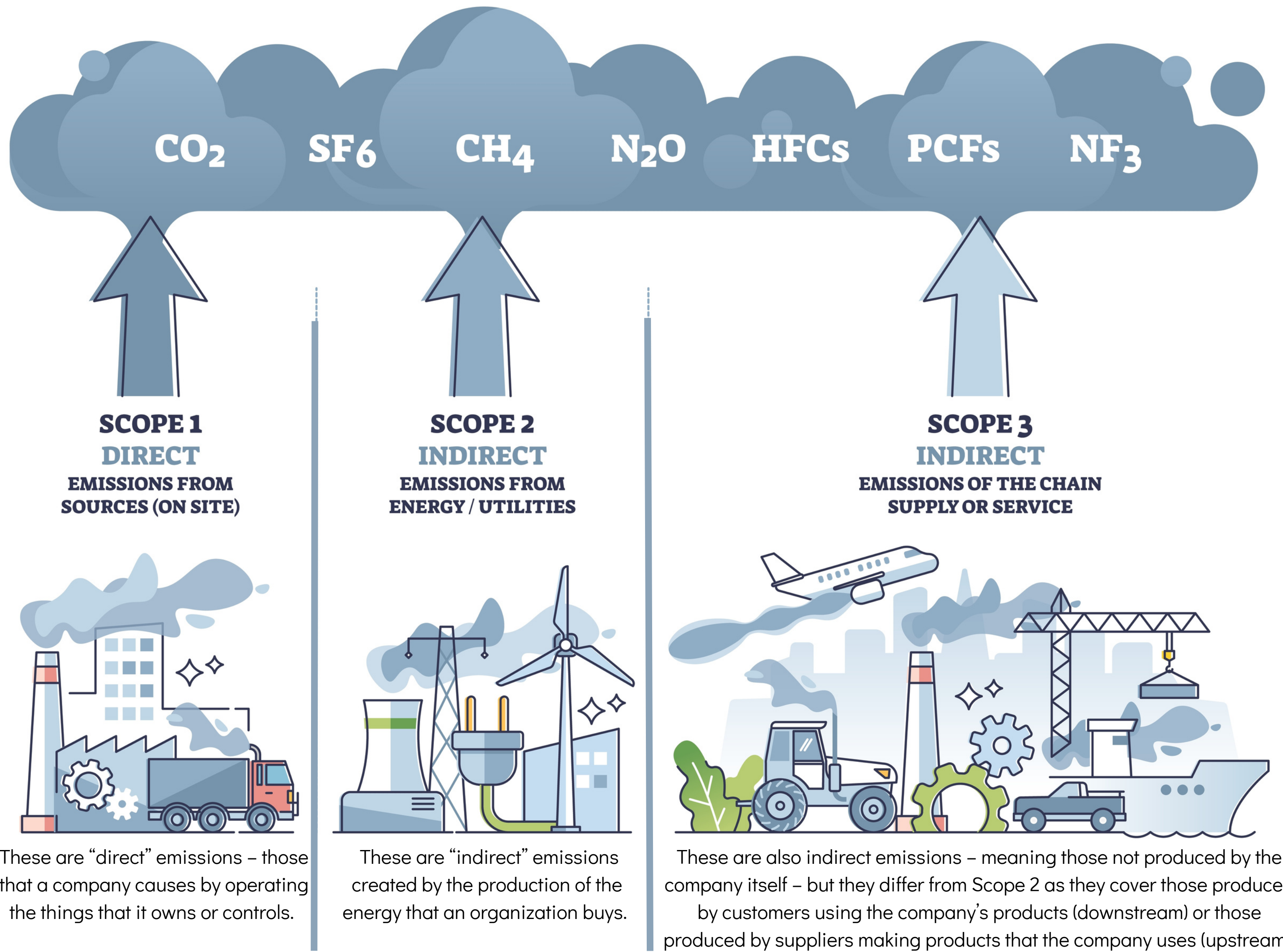


We've all heard of greenhouse gas emissions, but have you heard of Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 emissions?

Greenhouse gas emissions are divided into three categories for businesses and organizations
Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3.

Companies need to cut emissions across all three scopes to meet internationally agreed targets on global warming.

No prizes for guessing which of the three scopes is the hardest to tackle – and it is often the most significant.

Scope 3 emissions are nearly always the big one.

Companies can normally easily measure their Scope 1 and 2 emissions, and can control them by taking steps like switching to renewable energy or electric vehicles. But Scope 3 emissions are under the control of suppliers, so they are affected by decisions made outside the company. That means measuring Scope 3 emissions involves tracking activities across the entire business model – or value chain – from suppliers to end users.
